Speaking of grades, be aware that your grades this term **WILL AFFECT** your Fall sports eligibility.


Therefore, if you are interested in playing sports during the Fall, you need to be working on passing your classes. Make your best effort!

Who: Middle school and high school girls from anywhere in the country



Helix Junior, Adeline, was part of their 2019-2020 inaugural class!


