# CSU Eligibility Index and Impaction

- Your Eligibility Index is calculated using your grade point average (**GPA**) **and your ACT or SAT score**. The index will help tell if you're eligible for admission to the CSU.
- Please be advised that **due to impaction**, many campuses **have supplemental admission criteria**.
- When the number of applications received by a CSU campus from qualified applicants is greater than the number of available spaces, a campus is considered “**impacted**” for undergraduate degree programs.

## SAT

- 3 sections:
  - Critical Reading
  - Math
  - Writing (optional)
- \$64.50 with writing portion
- Score between 400 - 1600

## ACT

- 5 sections:
    - English
    - Math
    - Reading
    - Science
    - Writing
  - \$67 with writing portion
  - Score between 1 - 36
- Can be used for CSU/UC/Private
  - Fee waivers available
  - Offered monthly, 7x per year
  - Free practice tests online
  - No penalty for wrong answers

# When to take the SAT/ACT


- **First SAT:** March or May (Junior Year)
- **First ACT:** February or April (Junior Year)
- **Second SAT:** June or August (Between Junior and Senior Year)
- **Second ACT:** June (Between Junior and Senior Year)
- **Third SAT (if needed):** October or November (Senior Year)
- **Third ACT (if needed):** October (Senior Year)

  - CSU's: No essay questions
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- Private Institutions: Personal Statement
  - Letters of Recommendation
    - Requests through Naviance
    - Brag sheet in Naviance
  - Interviews

*\*Remember, UCs and CSUs generally do not require any of the above*

# Steps to Complete:

1. Create list of colleges you want to go to
2. Determine application budget - Fee waivers
3. Develop Timeline for completing applications
4. Complete/Submit Applications
5. Complete/Submit FAFSA/Dream Act



# Your College List

These are colleges you have an interest in and would attend if admitted. There is no minimum or maximum for this list, but it should contain the following:

## **SAFETY** Schools

a college that you will almost certainly get into because your standardized test scores, class rank and high school grades are well above the average for admitted students. Also, safety schools will always have relatively high acceptance rates.

## **MATCH** Schools

a college that is likely to admit you because your grades, standardized test scores, and holistic measures are similar to those of typical students at the school.

## **REACH** School

A college where your academic credentials fall below the school's range for the average freshman. Reach schools are long-shots, but they should still be possible. If you have a 2.0 GPA, Harvard is not a reach school — it's a dream.”

# College Application Timeline

## **August:**

UC applications open (8/1)

- attend Club College to get assistance in completing application
- you may fill out application, but cannot submit until 11/1

Common Application open (8/1) and all out of state/private schools

- Used for many private colleges/universities
- Works in conjunction with Naviance
- Check college websites for deadlines

Out of State (8/1)

## **October:**

CSU Application opens (10/1)

- Attend Club College to have application reviewed BEFORE submitting
- Submit applications ASAP

## **November:**

UC and CSU Application due **NOVEMBER 30**

- Attend Club College to have application reviewed BEFORE submitting
