- Of a student in your class has a resume that he/she created in HF (Helix First) last year please make sure that he/she updates it. There is no need to create a new one. Please make sure that they are saving their resume in the correct folder.
- STEP : Have student make a copy of the "<u>Resume Template</u>" go to: <u>bit.do/helixresume</u>
- STEP 2: Change the title of the Google Doc to "Resume: Last Name, First Initial (ID#)"
  - Example: Resume: Dawq, S (1234)
- STEP 3: Save/Organize the Resume into your Google Drive "Portfolio"
   folder
- STEP 4: Edit the Resume to include your information for each category
  - Use the <u>Resume Example</u>, <u>Writing a Resume</u>, and <u>Resume</u> <u>Breakdown</u>, to complete each section of the resume.
  - Please keep in mind that for many students there will be a lot of blank spaces. Consider the blank spaces as opportunities for places where you can get involved and do things that may be of value for your college & career goals.
