GETTING TO KNOW YOU: THIS OR THAT (if time permits)

- o In order to encourage participation in your class try a couple rounds of "this or that". Depending on your room and the amount of students in your class, you can either use pair shares or have the students move from one side of the room to another. Students will choose a stance on each pairing and then be asked to debate why they made the choice they did.
 - Example questions:

 - Would you rather be the first person to explore a planet or be the inventor of a drug that cures a deadly disease?
 - Would you rather fight 100 duck-sized horses or 1 horse-sized duck?
 - Would you rather be without elbows or without knees?

GETTING TO KNOW YOU: NAME DROPPER

Sitting in a circle, a person begins the game by saying his/her first name preceded by a descriptive word that rhymes or begins with the same letter. For examples: Loud Lulu, Creative Chris. Uniqueness will be remembered. The second person repeats the first person's introduction, and adds his/her own. The third person begins with the first, repeats the second, and add his/her own, and so on.
