DISTRIBUTE "STUDENT COURSE REQUEST PROFILES"

 - Changes need to be indicated on the form and signed off by a parent/guardian
 - Due to a printing error, a limited number of students do not have a printed section to include signatures. Please instruct them to indicate changes and sign anywhere on the form
 - Only changes that the student is qualified for will be granted (regarding prerequisites, etc)
 - These forms (if changes are being made) are due by **WEDNESDAY 3/11** to ensure that we have time to make these adjustments
 - The requests may not reflect placement levels in honors classes and LOTE placement tests
 - We are still pending results from multiple placement tests and will adjust when we receive those results
 - Changes made after 3/2 may not be reflected in the print out. If a student turned in an Honors/AP waiver or a change on their initial meeting form, they will be changed in the computer, but possibly not on the print out (if it was turned in after we had printed).
 - Students may visit Mrs. Gunion or Ms. Meza to ensure that the change has been made if they would like to verify
