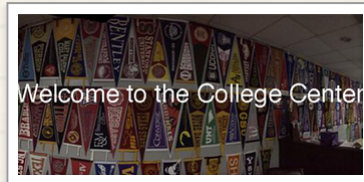

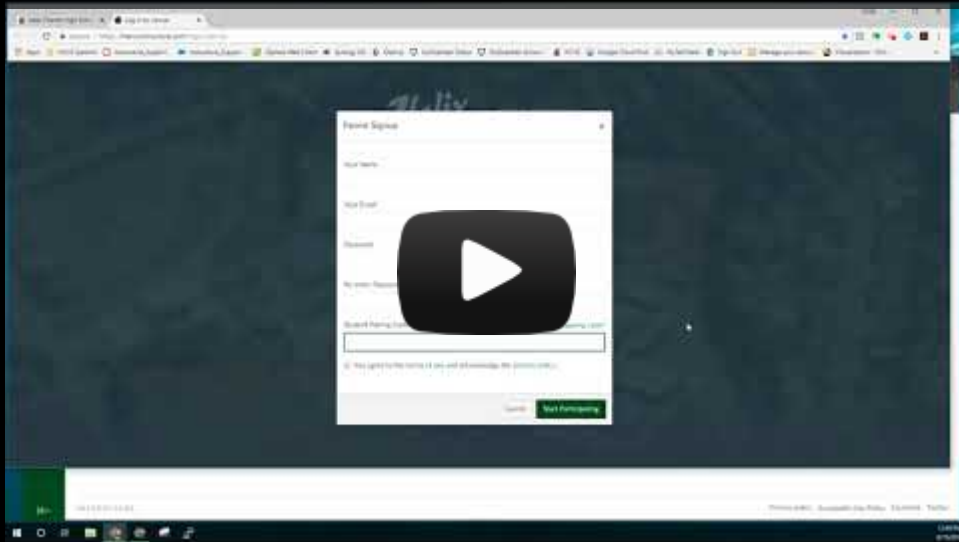

CHROMEBOOK INSURANCE

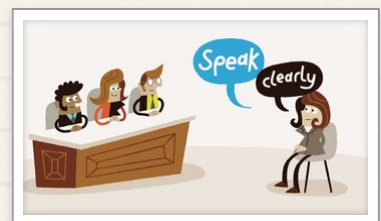
Parents/Guardians -

The HCHS Student Support Department would like to welcome Parents/Guardians to sit and talk with us on topics that are relevant to High School Students.

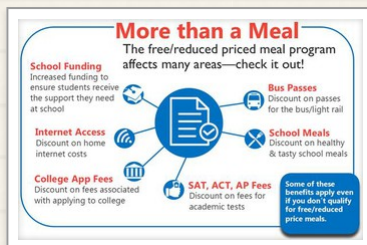

WHY ARE TEENAGERS SO SLEEP-DEPRIVED? A PERFECT STORM OF BIOLOGY, TECHNOLOGY AND HOMEWORK
