- **Protective factors**: are personal and environmental characteristics that help protect people from harm. These include:
  - Connectedness to family, community and social institutions
  - Problem-solving and coping skills
  - Access to effective behavioral health care
  - A sense of purpose or meaning in life.
- It is easy to forget all the good things that are happening in our life and sometimes we need to be reminded.
- Please Pass out Yellow bookmarks (will be delivered to you) and have students fill them out.
- As students fill out bookmark play Video from Logics VMA performance of 1-800-273-TALK (8255).
- Highlight:
  - The importance of identifying their strengths or what is going well in their lives. As well as the importance of identifying safe coping skills.
  - The back of the card about ACT (Acknowledge, Care, Tell)
    - Acknowledge: Listen to your friend, don't ignore threats.
      - Care: Let your friend know your care!
      - *Tell* a trusted adult that you are worried about your friend
