Student Attendance and Engagement

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

During Distance Learning, student attendance is tracked via student engagement in Distance Learning. Since students are not physically in a classroom, teachers track student attendance based on how much the student is engaged in the Synchronous (zoom) and Asynchronous (assigned in Canvas) work.


For classes that meet would normally meet every day, the expectation is for students to have 5-7 hours of engagement per course. Two of those hours can be through the Synchronous (zoom) classes. The remaining hours are from student submission or completion of the assigned Asynchronous work in Canvas and/or attending tutorial.

For classes that would normally meet every other day (A Day and B Day classes), the expectation is for students to have 3-5 hours of engagement per course. One of those hours can be through the Synchronous (zoom) class. The remaining hours are from student submission or completion of the assigned Asynchronous work in Canvas and/or attending tutorial.

Parents/Guardians will be notified via a phone caller if their student missed any of their Synchronous zoom classes. If your student is absent, having technical difficulties, and/or ill, please email or call the appropriate attendance technician to have the absence excused.


