


To our SUCCE22 Team,



Covid-19 Grading Policy for Spring Semester 2 (Quarter 4) 2019-2020 School Year

Transition from Traditional Grading of Student Achievement to Pass "P" or No Mark "NM"

Credit/No Credit. Students earning an "NM" must retake the course.

Conduct Grade & Work Habit Grade

Conduct = Student Behavior Work Habit = Student Engagement & Participation in Distance Learning

Grade Point Average (GPA)

P's & NM's will not be included in the calculation of students' GPA.

Grossmont/Cuyamaca - Helix Dual Enrollment Classes

Will continue to receive letter grades. Students can request a change to grading through the end of the semester (*June 1, 2020*).

Grossmont/Cuyamaca Articulated Credit Classes

Will accept Pass/No Mark as the standard for college credit. Students should try to maintain as high a PASS as possible.


