  - STEP 1: Have student make a copy of the "<u>SLO Worksheet</u>" go to: bit.do/sloworksheet
  - STEP 2: Change the title of the Google Doc to "SLO: Last Name, First Initial (ID#)"
    - Example: SLO: Dawq, S (1234)
  - STEP 3: Save/Organize the SLO Worksheet into your Google Drive
    "2021 Portfolio" folder
  - STEP 4: Begin reviewing the SLO's using the SLO Google Slide.

#### This week:

- STEP 1: Have students pull up their "SLO Worksheet" which should be saved in their 2021 Portfolio
- STEP 2: Continue in the <u>SLO Goolge Slide</u> on Slide 7 (or wherever your class left off) to cover the remaining SLOs. Each slide includes the SLO description and a GLP video (please be patient with last years videos-we know it says Class of 2021)
  - Functional Producers
  - Involved Citizens
  - Self-Directed Learners
  - Healthy People
  - Have students work in pairs to come up with examples of where the outcomes are being developed in classes and activities. Provide examples of things that happen in your classes. The examples should be typed into their worksheet.
  - The worksheet will be a reference tool as Helix works to integrate SLOs more comprehensively in our work.
