Content Area	Think of a time in your life when
History (American Revolution)	You felt like revolting against authority
Literature (Macbeth)	You wanted something so badly that you were willing to break the rules to get it
Biology (stress response)	You get stressed out and experienced one or more physical, mental, or emotional disturbances
Mathematics (probability)	You weighed the possibilities/probabilities of doing something that was potentially dangerous
Social Science (prejudice)	You discriminated against someone because he or she was difference from you OR someone else discriminated against you
Physics (Newton's first law of motion)	You felt like staying in bed indefinitely until one of you parents yelled at you to get up
Chemistry (Boyle's Law)	You felt like you were under a lot of pressure
Foreign Language (Spanish)	You really needed to speak
