






FINANCIAL AID APPLICATIONS

- FEDERAL AID (FAFSA)
- STATE AID (CAL GRANT)
- UNIVERSITY GRANTS
- BOARD OF GOVENORS FEE WAIVER

(COMMUNITY COLLEGE ONLY)

FEDERAL AID

FAFSA APPLICATION ONLY

- Pell Grant (Need Based)
 - Can get up to \$5,000 if eligible
 - Expected Family Contribution (EFC) must be ZERO
 - Information on tax forms will determine EFC
- Work study
 - Do this in place of Loans
 - Allowed to work on campus 2
 - Paid once a month
 - The amount you earn can't exceed your total Work-Study Award
- Loans
 - Subsidized (Better)- No interest charged while going to school
 - Unsubsidized- Interest begins accruing while going to school
 - Fixed interest rate on both Subsidized and Unsubsidized loans (currently 3.76%)

... STATE AID continued

- Chafee Grant
 - Current or former foster youth
- Middle Class Scholarship
 - Family income of less or equal to \$150,000
 - The award is based on a sliding scale according to family income
 - Limited to no more than 40% of your institution's system-wide tuition

University Grants

- State University Grant at CSU's
 - Designated to pay a portion of your basic tuition and fees
 - Amount cannot exceed the cost of basic tuition and fees
- EOP Grant
 - Limited amount of funding
 - Not every EOP student will be eligible

Board of Govenors Fee Waiver (BoG Fee Waiver)

- Available specifically for students at California community colleges
- Will waive your per-unit enrollment fee (currently \$46) at any community college throughout the state.
- Will NOT cover books and supplies (Cal Grant may help with these expenses)

- Do NOT Auto-disqualify your self
- \$2.9 Billion went unused in 2013-14 school year
 - Nearly \$400 million just in California
- You MUST apply every year
