- Get to know your kids!

- Do some icebreaker activities to get to know your kids.
- Examples:
 - **Namedropper:** Sitting in a circle, a person begins the game by saying his/her first name preceded by a descriptive word that rhymes or begins with the same letter. For examples: Loud Lulu, Creative Chris. Uniqueness will be remembered. The second person repeats the first person's introduction, and adds his/her own. The third person begins with the first, repeats the second, and add his/her own, and so on.
