# College Degrees



**Jndergraduate Degrees** 

**Associate's Degree (AA, AS)**: 2-year degree

**Bachelor's Degree (BA, BS)**: 4-year college degree (although may take more time)

aduate Degrees

Master's Degree: Advanced College Degree (Often 2-3 years to complete)

Doctorate Degree: Advanced
College Degree Beyond Master's
(Ranges in time to complete- usually
3+ years)

# Different College Systems

#### 1. COMMUNITY COLLEGES

- Earn a certificate, an Associate's degree or credits for transfer.
- Usually no on-campus housing, must commute
- No minimum GPA for admission
- Cheapest college option
- CA Promise now provides your first year free tuition
- CA Community College Tuition: \$46/unit (\$1,104 for 12 units)





### 2. California State Universities (CSU)

- Earn a Bachelor's degree
- 23 Campuses
- Considers GPA (special A-G calculation) and test scores for admission
- On-campus housing offered
- Greater focus on hands-on careers, practical skills, etc.
- Average Tuition and Fees: \$7,510

# 3. University of California (UC)

- Earn a Bachelor's degree
- 9 Undergraduate Campuses
- Considers applications holisticallygrades, scores, honors, PIQs, service
  - Min GPA: 3.0 (special A-G calculation)
- On-campus housing offered
- Great focus on research
- Average Tuition and Fees: \$13,900

# 4. Private Schools (In and Out of State)

- Earn a Bachelor's degree
- Over 1,500 private colleges in the U.S.
- Each has a different application process
  - Many use the Common App.
- On-campus housing often offered
- Vary in focus, variety of majors offered







# 4. Private Schools (In and Out of State)

- Often smaller campuses/class sizes
- May or may not have a religious affiliation
- Average Tuition and Fees: Varies-The initial price tag may be higher, but private schools often give more scholarships and grants.







### 5. Out-of-State Schools

- Earn a Bachelor's degree
- Application process varies
- Variety of majors and programs
- May have cheaper housing options
- Average Tuition and Fees: Varies You will pay higher tuition as an out-of state resident, BUT some have great options and grants available.

# A Few Things to Keep in Mind


- **Reputation is NOT everything.** There are so many amazing schools that you may have never heard of don't limit yourself on name only.
